• Clinched the men's singles title at the ITTF Challenge Croatia Open, defeating compatriot Kristian Karlsson with a 4–1 scoreline.

December 2020:

• Played a pivotal role in Borussia Düsseldorf regaining the Champions League title, being named the tournament's most valuable player.

Contributed to Sweden's bronze medal in the men's team event at the World Team Table
Tennis Championships held in Halmstad, Sweden, marking a significant achievement on home
soil.

• Dominated the European Youth Championships by winning the Junior Boys Singles title, showcasing his versatility and talent at a young age.

• Transitioned to professional play by joining TTC Ruhrstadt Herne in the German second Bundesliga, gaining valuable experience in a competitive environment.
