Her quick reflexes and aggressive play make her a formidable opponent. Off the table, she is recognized for her dedication, professionalism, and ability to overcome cultural and language barriers, endearing her to teammates and fans alike.

BREAKTHROUGH MOMENTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

2013:

October:

- Her participation in the European Championships marked her debut in major international competitions representing Germany, where she contributed to the team's gold medal victory.

2016:

August:

- Winning the silver medal at the Rio Olympics was a pivotal moment, elevating her status in international table tennis and highlighting her as a key player for Germany.

CAREER

Born in Anshan, Liaoning, China, Shan Xiaona developed her table tennis skills within China's competitive sports system. In the early 2010s, she moved to Germany, seeking broader opportunities in her professional career. After acquiring German citizenship, she became eligible to represent Germany in international competitions from 2013 onwards. Her aggressive penhold playing style, combined with her experience, made her a valuable asset to the German national team.
