PLAYING STYLE AND PERSONALITY

Annett Kaufmann is a left-handed shakehand player known for her fearless attacking style and tactical adaptability. She thrives in fast-paced exchanges, using early timing and sharp placement to pressure opponents. Her confident on-table presence, combined with mental resilience and strategic awareness, allows her to challenge higher-ranked and more experienced players. Recognized as one of Germany's rising stars, Kaufmann embodies the new generation of leadership and ambition in German table tennis.

BREAKTHROUGH MOMENTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

2025

European Championships (Zadar)

Played a decisive role in Germany's gold-medal triumph in the women's team event, winning key

matches and confirming her status as a core figure in Europe's strongest national squad.

German National Championships

- Successfully defended her women's singles national title, underlining her position as Germany's leading female singles player and showing consistency under domestic pressure.

WTT Champions & WTT Circuit (2025 Season)

- Established herself as a regular competitor at Champions and Contender level, reaching the Round of 16 at major WTT events and gaining valuable experience against the world's elite.

2024

World Youth Championships (Helsingborg)

- Captured the women's U19 singles world title, marking a defining breakthrough at global level and announcing her arrival as one of the most promising young players in the sport.

German National Championships

- Claimed national titles in both singles and doubles, confirming her dominance on the domestic stage.

2021

European Under-21 Championships (Spa)

- Won the women's singles title, a key milestone in her transition from youth success to senior-level contention.

2019

European Youth Top-10 (Tours)

- Won the U19 singles title, standing out as Europe's top youth player and laying the foundation for her later senior achievements.

CAREER

Annett Kaufmann is a German international table tennis player who rose through the junior ranks with European and World Youth titles, becoming the first European female to win the U-19 World Youth Championships singles crown in 2024. She represented Germany at the Paris Olympic Games and has since established herself as a key member of the senior national team, winning back-to-back German national singles titles (2024, 2025) and contributing to Germany's European Team Championship victories in 2023 and 2025. Her senior career continues to build through consistent appearances at WTT Champions and Contender events.

LEGACY AND FUTURE GOALS

Kaufmann is widely seen as one of Germany's brightest post-Timo Boll era talents, already leaving her mark with historic youth titles and national senior successes. As of 2025, she is a central figure in the German team with ambitions to climb the world singles rankings, lead her country in major team events, and contend for medals at the World Championships and Olympic Games in the coming years.
